Prevention, Intervention & Education

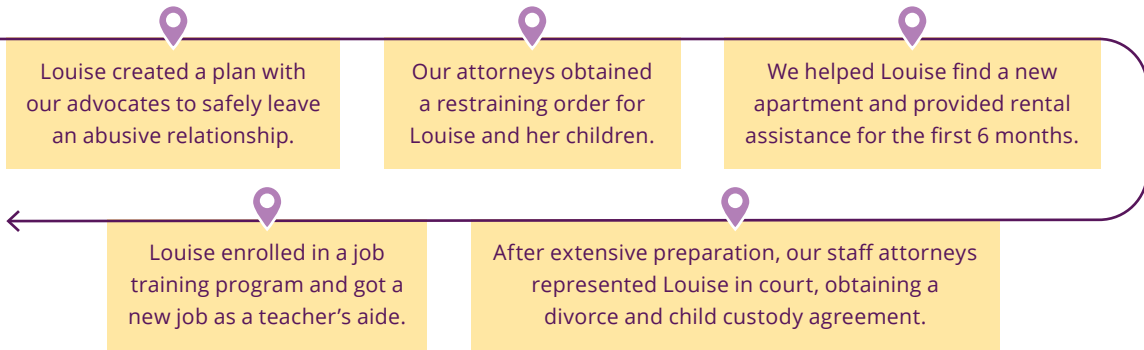


Our domestic violence advocates work with survivors on safety planning, accessing resources, and achieving long term stability. Our team also provides outreach and education in the community.

Our wraparound services help over 400 survivors and their children each year. Here is one example of how our services make an impact:

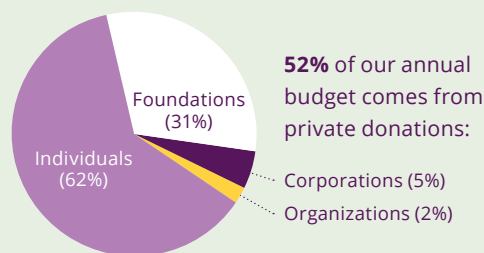
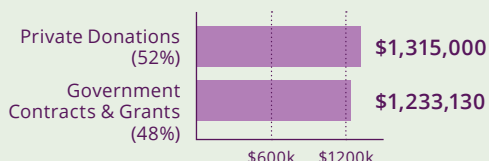

FAMILY LAW
195 survivors sought legal representation for matters ranging from divorce to child custody.



HOUSING
This year, Transitional Living Advocates facilitated the move to permanent housing for **34** survivors and their families.



EMOTIONAL SUPPORT
Prevention, Intervention & Education Advocates provided healing-focused care to **96** survivors.



RESTRAINING ORDERS
71 survivors represented by Steps to Justice obtained restraining orders, often the foundation for true healing and independence.
